This funding will be used to

- Ensure all students are achieving National Minimum Standards (NMS) in Literacy and Numeracy OR have an Individual Learning Guarantee (ILG) for students not on target to reach NMS.
- Increase the percentage of students in the NAPLAN Upper 2 Bands (U2B) to above 40% in Year 3 and above 30% in Year 5 (based on improving 2014 data) in Reading.
- Increase the percentage of students in the NAPLAN Upper 2 Bands (U2B) to above 30% in Year 3 and above 30% in Year 5 (based on improving 2014 data) in Writing.
- Increase the percentage of students in the NAPLAN Upper 2 Bands (U2B) to above 30% in Year 3 and above 30% in Year 5 (based on improving 2014 data) in Numeracy.
- Improve teacher capacity through coaching, professional development and feedback.

Our initiatives include

- Building teacher and staff capabilities in Reading, Writing and Numeracy by providing coaching, mentoring, peer observations and feedback.
- Monitoring and reviewing student performance each term in Reading, Writing, Spelling and Number "Focus on Five".
- Providing targeted feedback on goals – *Hattie, J (2012) Visible Learning for Teachers*.
