English

Mathematics

Learning Area Content

Mathematics

Our learning intention this term is to work towards our knowledge of numbers, shapes and directions.

This term, students will learn how to partition two-digit numbers in different ways and into tens and ones. They will learn to solve addition and subtraction word problems to 20 using mathematical modelling. Students will investigate 2D shapes and their features; they will match them to objects found in the environment. Students will learn to give and follow directions that move people and an object within a given space.

Physical Education

The learning intention this term is for students to develop their skills in Athletics.

Music

The learning intention this term is for students to continue to learn a set of songs and rhymes while practicing active listening skills as well as developing their performance skills. Through these experiences, students will identify where, why and/or how people across cultures, communities and/or other contexts experience music.

Health

The learning intention this term is for students to explore what keeps them safe in and around the classroom. They will develop a bank of help seeking strategies and learn how to keep themselves and others safe.

Inquiry 'What do living things need?'



English

Our learning intention this term is to write a folio of Information Reports and improve our reading and comprehension skills.

Reading

Students will read aloud, focusing on developing fluency. They will demonstrate knowledge of the relationship between sounds and letters, sight words and punctuation. They will answer literal and implied questions.

Writing, Speaking and Listening

Students will create a folio of Information Reports that shows their understanding of the connection between writing and images. When writing, students will provide details about the animals and/or plants habitat and diet. They will practice using capital letters and full stops. Students will continue to practice spelling, sight words and words with regular spelling patterns.

Science

The learning intention this term is for students to create a diorama showing the needs of their chosen living thing. They will use everyday vocabulary to communicate their observations, findings and ideas.
