Learning Area Content

Physical Education

Students will participate and practise tennis skills.

Music

This semester, students will increase their repertoire of songs, clapping rhymes and musical games which reinforce beat, rhythm and tuneful singing and elements of music. Students will have the opportunity to try solo singing, co-operating with a partner and working as a group, and experimenting with tuned and untuned percussion instruments in informal settings. They will be introduced to music theory and its terminology.

Health

Students will be recognising and working on their personal and social capabilities through recognising safe and health behaviours.

English

This term, students will work on their reading and writing skills. They will expand their knowledge of letter recognition and sounds. Students will write simple and compound sentences. Students will create retells on books that have interest to them.
